Updating 1/3

- CILAP organized the first two Meetings of the National Network. The **meetings took place in Rome and Naples**, with the aim of launching and establishing the “National Network for Minimum Income.”
- EMIN was also presented in Ascoli and Bari (June), Verona (Sept.), Varese and Reggio Calabria (Oct.) during the meetings on “Poverty and social exclusion, which role for Regions and Local communities”, in reference to the next program financing 2014-2020

Updating 2/3

- Different agencies and organizations of civil society , with different points of view on MI, participated in the meetings, **CILAP being aware (and trying to make a synthesis) of the different positions** and the plurality of definitions that have developed around the issue over time

Updating 3/3

- **The meetings were well attended.**
- **The EMIN project has aroused great interest** and a wide-ranging discussion, analysing the various measures adopted over the years in Italy by the Central Authorities, the Regions and the Municipalities, aimed at supporting the income of individuals and families.
- **Over 200 people from organizations, Public Entities and NGOs.** participated in the meetings and in the other initiatives where ENIM was discussed.

What went on in 2013

1/3

- On April 15, a **citizens' legislative initiative** for a **GARANTEED MINIMUM INCOME** was delivered to the Parliament.
- The proposed bill was the result of the Campaign for a Guaranteed Minimum Income, launched in 2012, which collected **more than 50 thousand signatures** throughout Italy

What went on in 2013

2/3

- Several political parties have presented their draft laws:
 - ✓ Democratic party = Establishment of a Minimum Income Scheme for Active Citizenship
 - ✓ Left Party = Establishment of a Guaranteed Minimum Income
 - ✓ 5 Stars Mov. = Provisions for the Establishment of a Citizenship Income

What went on in the 2013

3/3

- Reis = Reddito di inclusione sociale (social inclusion income) and Anti Poverty Alliance promoted by Caritas and Fiopds (Italian branch of Feantsa)
- SIA = Study on Active Inclusion Support promoted by the Minister of Labour

Work planned and developed for the first National Report in this first year

- All participants in the meetings expressed their interest in joining the network and ready to **to cooperate for the analysis on the “state of the art”** in Italy.
- The first year was mainly spent:
 - launching the network and
 - Carrying out the **desk analysis**
 - **Preparing the questionnaire for interviewing partners, stakeholder, key-witnesses**
 - **Preparation of the first national report**
